

## Oct. 13<sup>th</sup> Bids for Kids by Dwight Eisnach

### Hundreds Gather at Annual Balistreri Event

More than 145 people, including nine persons from RMJC, ate, drank and bid vigorously to raise money for the Children's Hospital Adaptive Rehabilitation (ARCH) program and Ridge View Academy at the October 13th event at Balistreri Vineyards. The 40th annual Bids for Kids was presented by the Denver Round Table, the Rocky Mountain Region Porsche Club and RMJC.



Brent McGibbon, RMJC's representative on the Bids for Kids planning committee, again sponsored the pre-auction entertainment of jazz band MoDaZz that played during cocktails and will play



There were nearly 40 items auctioned at the event, split equally between silent auction and live auction bid items. Several of the live auction items such as week-long vacations in Maya Riviera, Maui and Lake Tahoe went for several thousands of dollars in response to the spirited and entertaining auctioneering provided by Gary Corbett, formerly of Colorado and now of Tucson. Watching Gary in action alone was worth the price of admission!

After years of golf tournaments and car tours, the three sponsoring organizations changed the fundraising format to an evening at Balistreri a few years ago and 100% of funds raised go directly to the charities. The evening's Emcee was CBS4 weather and news anchor Ed Greene, and since Ed and Gary are longtime friends the banter between the two was lively and added humor and spice to the evening.




For the clock photo, you need to hold the camera in what is called Portrait format, long ways top to bottom. You also need to stand back further than you usually do.


