About one half mile west of I-25 I was surrounded by cars: one in front, one in front to the right, one on my right side and many behind me. I was in the far left lane, Suddenly a small deer stepped in front of me. He had just crossed the east bound lane, jumped the fence and now I saw his gangly legs in front of my left head light. He was trying to cross.

I had no options. I was boxed in and had no time to react except to tighten my grip on the steering wheel and brace my arms. The deer collided with my left head light, pushing in parts of the heavy metal bonnet and pushing the bumper downward. The deer bounced around the left side striking the body panel and the door. 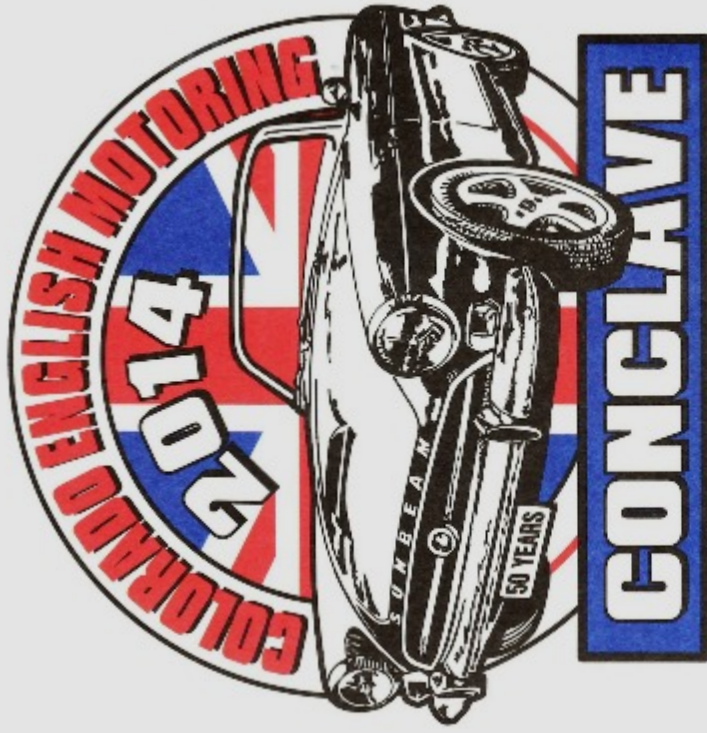

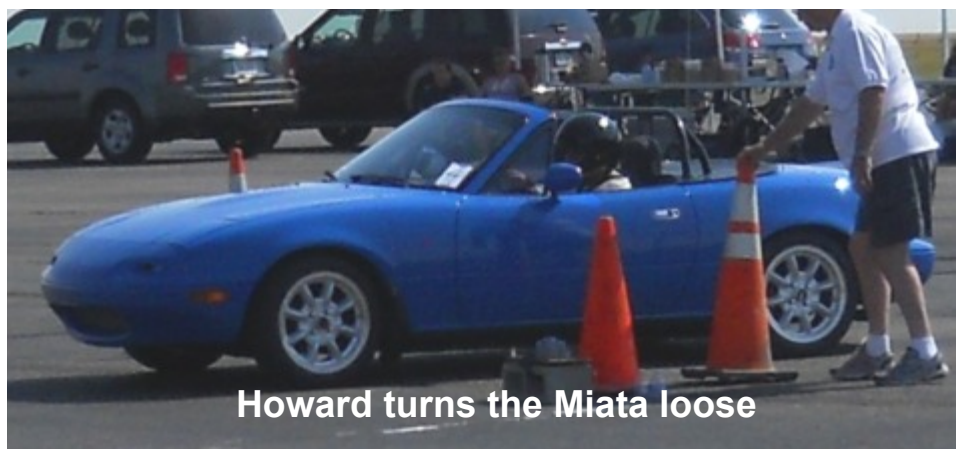
gauge in the car showed 100 degrees!! Great fun! We hope you all make it down to Cheyenne Mountain State Park for the Slalom at Western States!
