



He reviewed those legislators he has worked with in the past, some of whom are term-limited and will not be returning. He noted that with term limits in place, lobbyists are often called on to provide background on bills under consideration.


The political committee will meet with Leo to discuss where donations will be most effective in promoting collector car interests. Issues of concern to hobbyists include single license plate authorization, potential limits on sales of cars by individuals, air quality and emission tests, and verification of insurance coverage by other motorists.


