Thanks to all for a delightful Dust-Off.



### Collector Car Council of Colorado, Inc. Minutes Meeting, 7 May 2014

**Legislation:** Leo Boyle reported that Gov. Hickenlooper has signed HB 14-1299 as well as HB 14-1100, both bills having dealt with branding vehicles with "salvage" titles. Leo reviewed the lobbying that was behind both bills but noted that CCC was able to amend each to protect the interests of collectors. The contacts that club members made with their senators (and representatives) were crucial in making changes. 14-1299 sought to eliminate the six year vehicle age exemption from salvage titles but the final version provides that vehicles eligible for collector series designation as well as horseless carriage and street rods are still exempt.


