

## 1<sup>st</sup> Annual Pat's Cool Cats for Big Cats October 12, 2014

A few years back Pat Grossman had a run planned to go see the amazing big cats: Lions, Tigers, Leopards and Jaguars at the Wild Animal Sanctuary in Keenesburg Colorado. The run was cancelled due to an ice storm, but this year we pulled it off and plan on doing it every year as a Fall Drive.

We started at the Starbucks in Golden where we had 4 Jags, a Masserati and our friend Erik Bergman from Hagerty with his family in their SUV. We left as planned, shortly after 10:30 and made the 40 odd mile trek to the Pepper Pod in Hudson – a 101 year old restaurant! At last count there were 35 people in attendance at lunch and a few more Jags in the parking lot.



After lunch several people decided that the chill fall air was not suitable for viewing the wildlife and/or had other commitments. None-the-less 23 of us did make the short drive to the Wild Animal Sanctuary where we had reserved parking and our hostess Becky Maitlen greeted us and prepared us for a tour. Several of those unable to join sent their entry fee as a donation for some \$450 total with those present, and many did bring additional donations of frozen turkeys, fresh apples and other edibles for the animals. Additionally many of us bought items in the gift shop.



Becky gave us a wonderful intro to the Sanctuary before she and her colleague Kent took us for a private, guided tour of the facility. Although it was brisk, the cool temperature made for excellent viewing of the animals. Leopard, lions and tigers are the main attraction, and there are wolves, bear, bob cats, foxes and other critters. As always with RMJC, a good time was had by all!!

We had some initial conversation with Becky about the possibility of RMJC sponsoring an actual Jaguar to the sanctuary – it was the first big cat to the facility in the beginning, but there are none right now because they are very difficult to breed in captivity and therefore there are few needing rescuing in the world – we will keep looking at this and perhaps even look into sponsoring Jaguar habitat in the world – we'll keep you informed. We hope you'll all come out next year.




