CCCC Minutes

Due to Corona-19 virus lockdown, this was a "hybrid" meeting, partially in-house at the Forney Transportation Museum in Denver and partly via Zoom over the internet.

Legislative: Leo Boyle reported that the Colorado Legislature will convene on January 13th for swearing in but will then adjourn and reconvene on February 16th, hoping that vaccines and social distancing will have brought the Covid-19 epidemic somewhat under control. He is not aware of any proposed legislation that would affect the car collecting hobby. Recognizing the financial difficulties due to lack of certain fundraising in 2020 and 2021, Leo Boyle has offered to be "furloughed" for the time being. He intends to still monitor bills at the Legislature and will advice CCCC of those that could affect us but he will not actively be involved with attending hearings. Assessment for legislative activity will be reduced from \$4 per club member to \$1 per member.

RMJC Members: With concerns about CCCC's operating expenses and lack of income, the RMJC Board voted to give the CCCC the usual \$4 per member, which comes to \$350, including their \$50 CCCC membership fee.

The Airport Show and Swap Meet event is tentatively set for Saturday, August 14, 2021.

(COVENTRY, UK) – December 9, 2020 – Jaguar is marking the 60th anniversary of the E-type sports car in 2021 with the introduction of a new limited-edition 575 hp V8 Supercharged F-TYPE Heritage 60 Edition. Just 60 examples of these all-wheel drive sports cars will be available for sale worldwide*, each one hand-finished by the personalization experts at SV Bespoke.

A specially curated commemorative specification includes solid Sherwood Green paintwork, an original E-type color that hasn't been offered on a new Jaguar vehicle since the 1960s, and extended duo-tone Caraway and Ebony Windsor leather interior trim which isn't normally available on the F-TYPE.

The new limited-run model also features a unique aluminum console finisher inspired by the rear-view mirror casing in the E-type, the E-type 60th anniversary logo embossed on the headrests of the lightweight Performance seats and "E-type 60" badging shared with the limited-edition E-Type 60 Collection vehicles announced by Jaguar Classic earlier this year. Commemorative treadplates, an SV Bespoke commissioning plaque and Caraway-edged carpet mats provide finishing touches.

The F-TYPE Heritage 60 Edition is available in both Coupe and Convertible body styles with exclusive Diamond-Turned Gloss Black 20-inch forged alloy wheels, Gloss Black and Chrome exterior accents and black brake calipers.

JCNA Updates

On January 11 th, JCNA convened a Board of Directors video conference to discuss the 2021 AGM. After reviewing the current status and reasonable pandemic forecasts we determined that attempting to hold the AGM in March 2021 would be unlikely to convene a quorum and we could not conduct a meeting. The March 2021 AGM is therefore deferred until travel risks are significantly reduced. Our contingency is to hold the AGM in Columbia in the 3 rd quarter or hold the AGM in late October. We will determine our course of action in our 6/14/21 Board meeting and update all Club Presidents at the time.
