And finally, I must give a huge shout too all of the people who have helped me so much for the past year. Without you all, I would have not been able to do anything. Many tanks to you all.

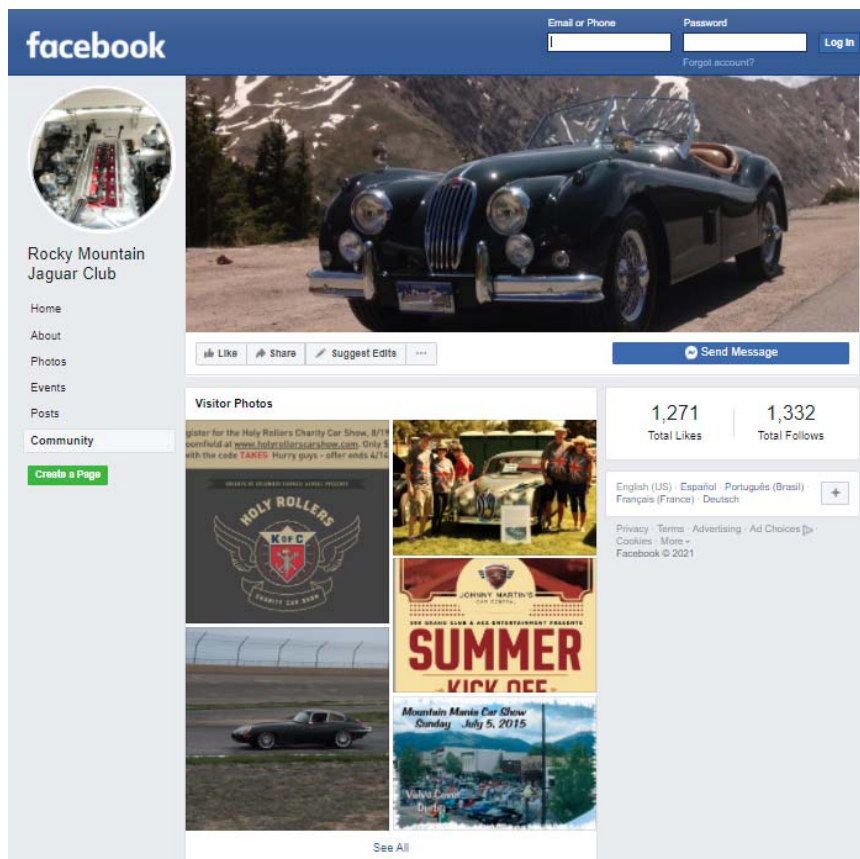
Do not forget to drive them while you still can. Let's have some fun!!!!

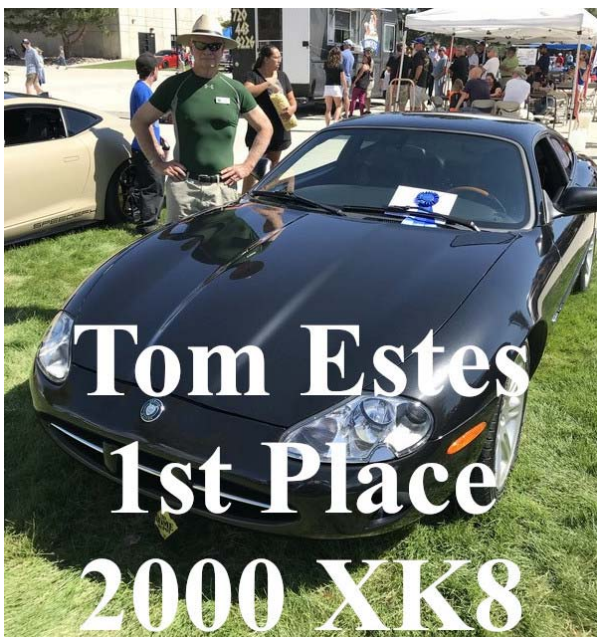

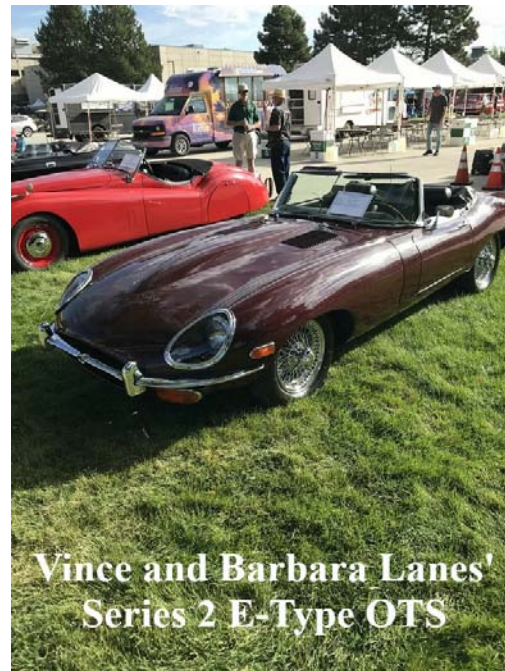

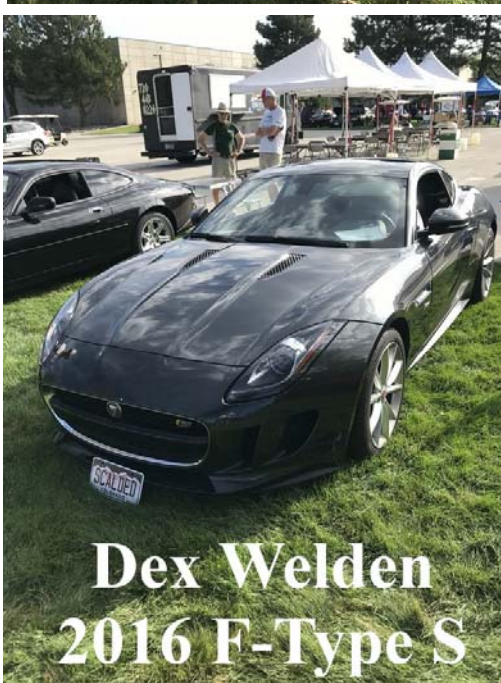

ACC Concours Resumes after COVID Interruption

On a warm sunny September day, the 38th annual Colorado Concours d'Elegance & Exotic Sports Car Show resumed after a one-year absence due to the pandemic. The total car count for the show was 312 (including two motorcycles), and although an official crowd estimate was not available, most observers noted a slightly smaller crowd and car show than before the COVID break.

Nevertheless, blue skies and conviviality prevailed to make the show as enjoyable as past years. The Jaguar corral was represented well under our familiar shade tree location as 16 beautiful and classic Jaguars lined up head-to-head. In addition, an E-Type lined up in the area for Elite Concours judging and a 2022 I-Pace provided by Stevenson Jaguar represented in the first-time electric vehicle corral. Much thanks to Mark Barnett, Stevenson Jaguar general manager, and salesman Max Wilson for prepping and bringing the I-Pace to the ACCO.

Absent the usual great homemade lunches we have under the Jaguar tent, this year's show featured food trucks on the concrete plaza at Arapahoe Community College. Although the food trucks provided good food, the lines were long, and most club members agreed we missed our own approach to lunch.

On the day before the September 12 Concours, Vince Lane, RMJC liaison to the Ability Connections planning committee, was joined by Bob Grossman, Frank Oakley, Ken Mulhall and Dwight Eismach for the annual setup of the Jaguar corral, as well as the Porsche, Aston Martin and other marques. Thanks to all those club members for pitching in to help preserve what is the best location in the show.

Three Jags were submitted for Club Judging, and as mentioned, one E-Type was submitted for Elite Concours judging. Club judged winners included a first-place blue ribbon for Henry Platts for his '61 E-Type OTS. Henry scored 243.2 out of a possible 244 points in the Concours d'Elegance scoring system. Tom Estes also scored a first-place ribbon for his 2000 XK8 Coupe with a score of

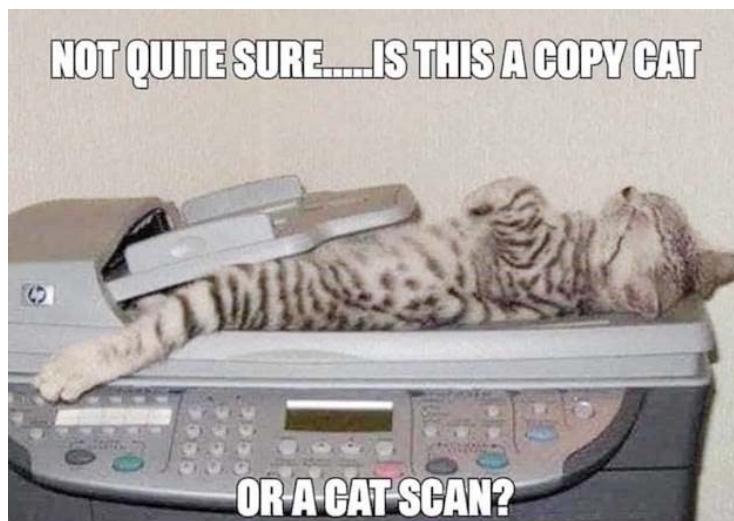
223.2. Mike and Deb Ramirez received a second-place red ribbon for their '69 E-Type OTS with a score of 238.9.

Randy Ackerman won a black ribbon for Favorite Jaguar in the corral for his stunning black 1957 XK-140 SE. And Bob Ottewill won first place in the Elite Concours judging for his champagne-colored 1967 E-Type OTS. Ottewill said his car was originally restored in 2000 and he has owned it since 2013.

Congratulations to all the winners, and a special thanks to RMJC judges Jon Strader, Henry Platts and Dwight Eismach for doing the club judging. And a final tip of the hat to Vince Lane who suffered through a dead car and dead cell phone through the day with smooth aplomb to guide the Jaguar part of the show while also working with Ability Connections staff to make sure that same day registration and parking of the exotic cars came off without a hitch.

Vince's 1970 E-Type roadster died when he parked it in the Jag corral early Sunday morning. As the show wrapped up in the afternoon Brian Redrupp provided a battery jump to Vince's car but to no avail. After testing the lights, it was determined the battery was not at issue. Repeated attempts to start the E-Type finally turned over the engine and Vince was able to drive home. A faulty starter was believed to be the source of the problem. Vince puts in many hours during the year with Ability Connections Colorado to represent the club's best interests and we appreciate his effort.
