

Collector Car Council of Colorado Meeting Minutes

The April CCCC Meeting was held in Colorado Springs. The Following clubs were in attendance:

Pikes Peak Vintage Motor Car Club of America – Weldon Shaffer; Pierce Arrow Club – Roger Sherman; Early Ford V8 Club – Russ Newnes; Auto Shop Air Force Academy –Ron Sherman; Pikes Peak Thunderbird Club – Ron Theisman

Leo Boyle, the lobbyist for the CCCC, gave a report. The current legislative session is 2/3 complete. He reported that there was an infusion of Federal dollars to the state, most of which will be used for education, infrastructure and fentanyl crises management. Senate bill 138 authored by Sen. Hanson was an effort to reduce green house gases and although not presented nor read in session it could have an effect on classic cars. House bill 1162 approved the use of "digital license plates" that would replace existing number plates was passed and awaiting the Governors signature and will go into effect in 2023.

Friends of Collector Cars is looking for funds to lobby the legislature and Ted Rossi is heading up this effort for CCCC.

The August 6th CCCC Airport Car show is asking member clubs to participate and rent swap space. The fee to have a space is \$40. CCCC is selling a new logo shirt to members. Cost \$29.97 plus \$8.00 per shirt to apply the CCCC logo.

The attendees were informed about a non-profit called "Friends of the Carpenter" that provides lo-cost cars to single mothers that are in financial need and maintenance to their existing cars. This includes oil changes, tire rotation and simple repairs. CCCC is looking for member clubs to work Satur-

days to help with the maintenance.

The Airport Car Show will include flybys with WWII P51 mustang fighters and attendees can be photographed with their car in front of the P51 for a fee. Money would go to the Friends of the Carpenter group.

Ron Sherman of the Air Force Academy Auto Shop spoke about their business that has Snap-On tools, lifts and expertise to those who want to work on their cars. He encouraged members to use the facility and let us know veterans can use the facility for free.

Future meeting locations was agreed upon. Six meetings will be held at the Forney Museum and six meetings would be at other locations including the Haggerty Insurance shop, Gateway Motors and one meeting per year in Colorado Springs. Meeting adjourned at 8:40 PM.

Two new additions for the <u>Jaguar F-Pace</u> SUV line-up have been revealed for



2022, adding a pair of new sub-SVR range-topping models to the brand's <u>Volvo XC60</u> and <u>BMW X3</u> rival.

Called 300 Sport and 400 Sport, the new duo are priced from £62,250 and £68,520 respectively, which means that only the 5.0-litre <u>V8 supercharged SVR model</u> is more expensive. Both use six-cylinder mild-hybrid power, with a diesel and a petrol option offered.

Steve had put together a power point presentation showing all the updated rules,

There were a number of administrative changes throughout the rule book. Things like the word "may" meaning the Judge may choose to do something or may choose not to do it. "May" has been changed to "must", this means the Judge is required to perform that task.

A few of the other changes are:

The Chief Judge(s) of the assisting club(s) must be notified #3a that a member of their certified judging team is being utilized at another club's Concours in order for them to obtain credit for their service. The Judge's certification can be verified by contacting the Chief Judge of the guest Judge's club or by contacting the JCNA administrator at 888-258-2534, Extension #9

If the Judge's status must be updated to conform to sanction requirements, it must be updated no less than 30 days prior to the date of the Concours event and the Concours Committee Chair must be notified this has been completed.

Conclave Committee Representative Needed


The Colorado English Motoring Conclave committee is seeking representatives from all British car clubs. Currently there are only 4 or 5 members on the committee and they need your help.
