### **CCCC** Minutes

The February meeting of the Collector Car Council of Colorado was called to order at 7:27 pm MST, by President Dick Thompson. 33 member clubs were signed in. Officers present were President Dick Thompson, 1st Vice President Tom Mansfield, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President Calvin Craig, Treasurer Samantha Baker, and Secretary Richard Fritz. Many club presidents were also signed in. Our host, Paul Anslow, Airport Director at RMMA was introduced. He presented personally-engraved whiskey bottles to the winners of the 2022 CCCC Airport Show:

Leo Boyle, lobbyist for the CCCC reported that the Colorado Legislature began its 2023 Session in January and will meet for 4 months. He expects that 400 to 500 bills will be introduced and he will be on the lookout for ones that affect the car hobby such as one advocating year-round use of E-15 (ethanol 15%) fuel which would be bad for vintage vehicles. Concours d'Elegance: Discussion with Tom Scott regarding the June 4th 2023 Concours in Littleton is continuing. The Concours is planning to feature evolution of the automobile with decades of vehicles grouped together. CCCC is urged to promote the show and we hope to provide 50 cars for the Evolution category. 




