New Business

Vince reported that RMJC members should look into Horseless Carriage License Plate Applications for vehicles that are at least 50 years old for several benefits over the regular annual car registrations. The Horseless Carriage plates provide the owner with multiple years of registration and exemption from bi-annual emissions testing. Although vehicle usage is limited to 4500 mi per year and only collector car related event



travel, the benefits are substantial. Similar rules and benefits apply for Collector Car plates for cars that are at least 25 year old. Colorado DMV also offers “Year of Manufacture” plates that replicate the license plates that were issued the same year as the year the car was manufactured.

The Higbee Law firm is at it again. RMJC has been targeted once again by this firm for sharing a Jaguar Press release in the newsletter. RMJC is a non-profit organization which should exempt from the lawsuits of this type because articles in the Newsletter are not used for profit. Vince has requested assistance from JCNA to resolve these issues for the last time.

The Board has been looking into a “Dust and Shine” event at the Forney Transportation Museum? Events like this help the staff of Forney keep their collection pristine. Participants get free admission to this amazing museum. Forney schedules Dust and Shine events on the 3rd Saturday of the month. Currently the available months are June, July, August, September, and October. Interested members should contact an Officer or Board member.

CCCC Meeting Updates

Legislative: Leo Boyle mentioned that he had attended the November 8 hearing at the Capitol of the special interim committee investigating ways to bring Colorado into compliance with EPA. Requirements on methane and ozone emissions. The committee appeared to be focusing on oil and gas well leakages. The committee will continue its investigations, analyses, and studies.

Budget for Operations for 2024 discussed and we are expecting a negative balance of \$817.00 for 2024. This Budget report was read and accepted. Gov’t Relations Account budget for 2024 is expecting a negative \$700 balance. Budget for the 2024 RMMA Car show expects a positive balance of \$3,360.

A proposal was offered to raise the per person fee for each member club by \$1. Glenn Manes of the Buick club opposed this per person raise and suggested that each club could volunteer to offer an additional per person fee. Overall discussion favored not raising the per person fee and a measure to raise was defeated by a vote of those present. A motion to have member clubs voluntarily offer an additional \$1 per member donation was voted and this amendment passed.

We have a member stepping up to take over management of the CCCC car show.



Dick Thompson asked for volunteers to take over the sub categories to help her in preparation for the show. i.e. Marketing; which includes putting notice in the Scoop, Radio ads, and flyers handed out at car shows, Sponsorship; which means signing on corporate and businesses to sponsor the show. Vendors and Displays; signing up food vendors for the show and the special interest displays. Lastly the Swap meet; signing up people to rent space for the swap meet. (John Ehrlich volunteered).
