Thanks to everybody who turned out last week at the Blue Bonnet as we celebrated Valentine's Day with special favors courtesy of Debbie Ramirez. Some 32 members enjoyed the fine food and beverages. We also welcomed Wayne and Debbie Anderson's new 2011 XKR into the fold and the car looks spectacular from the pictures I've seen. I'm sure Steve will find a space in the newsletter very soon so all of us can see what a fine acquisition they have made.

If you were at the February Club meeting on the 13th, you heard me talk about a new membership recruiting campaign being implemented by JCNA. Jack Humphrey from our sister club in Colorado Springs is on the 4 person Recruiting Team and Colorado is one of 7 states selected for a "test run". 




