

**Membership Report:** Deanie reported, “we have members”. The current membership is 126.

**Treasurer's Report:** Deanie reported that the club finances remain right on budget.

**CCCC Update:** Tom reported that the November 5<sup>th</sup> meeting of the CCCC was held at the Forney Museum with 42 clubs were in attendance. The Collector Car Council of Colorado has over 57 clubs enrolled (Website <https://collectorcouncil.com/>). Much discussion was done regarding CCCC fund raising for the organization. All funds are used to pay for a legislative consultant that works to influence any legislation for or against collector cars. The main fund raisers are the dues paid by the member clubs and the proceeds from the annual CCCC car show. At this year's show in August, two main sponsors dropped out and as such after expenses the total profit from the show was \$2000. Some discussion was centered around dispensing of the show and just raising the per member dues by from \$4 a member to \$5 a member. That alone would raise more funds than the show did this year. A vote on whether to proceed with the show or just raise the dues was delayed to the December meeting so the representatives of the clubs could poll their membership to see if paying a dollar more was acceptable or if not proceed with planning next year's show.

**Club Elections:** The election of RMJC officers was accomplished. All officers were retained except the Secretary. ## 2007-2009 XK Left Backup “Light” Not Working



For owners a 2007 to 2009 XK and have found that the **left side**, when you are standing behind the car, back up light is not working, here is some information that may be of interest.

Mike Ramirez happened to be standing behind our 2007 XK while I was backing our 2007 blue XK out of the garage so we could give them the tents for the Conclave. Mike noticed that the LEFT Reversing Lamp was not working. The Right side was, but not the Left.

OK, all the usual thoughts, bad bulb, bad fuse, shorted wire. So off comes the lift gate panels, out comes the light. Humm, no Bulb. It is a single LED unit all soldered together. OK, hooked some wires up and tested it against a battery. It happened to be lying face down, so I would not break it, but the light being generated was visible. So, put the light back in.

Talked with Jake, our mechanic friend at Lakewood, “Stevinson” Jaguar, “Nope, no fuse, no replaceable bulbs, probably a short somewhere”. Since the right side was working, would it be possible to just cut the wire going to the left backup light and tap the wire on the right backup and get it working that way? “Never done it, but that might work.” So, cut the wire, spliced it into the right side, had the car put in reverse. Deanie started the XK and put it in Reverse. The lights on both sides came on for less that a second, then nothing. Humm, got wiring diagram print-outs from Jake, looked at the drawings, it showed both left and right reversing lamps going to a single connection, so “That Should Have Worked!” But it didn’t.

My “Old Ford” friend, Loren, and I talked with Jake again, “Yup, probably a short somewhere.” Jake said, “The first thing to do is disconnect both the positive and negative battery cables and hold them together for 30 seconds”, I did it for a minute. Then Loren hooked the wires back up like they were originally. Yup, the right-side backup light worked, but not the left. We disconnected the right-side power and hooked it up to the left backup light. Interesting, when in reverse, it is not a White Light like the right side but the left side is RED! Called Service again. Just so happens that Pete, the service manager is British. “Pete, what does a Red light that is not a brake light mean”. “Oh, that’s easy, it’s a **FOG LAMP**.” “Fog Lamp?” “Just a single fog lamp?” “Yup!” Hooked the wires back up like the factory did.


On the 2007-09 there are two switches on the lower left portion of the dash above your left knee, that turn the Fog Lamps on, one on top for the front and the one on the bottom for the rear fog lamps. Shazam!!! Now the **Left FOG Lamp** works and it’s **RED!**

It is the Entrant’s job to know how to operate their car, so be sure to tell Judges that only the right is a Backup Lamp, the left is the Fog Lamp when Operational Verification is being performed at a concours.

Oh, and Loren looked in the Owner’s Manual, there is nothing about this on page 75 or anywhere else in the 2007 XK Owner’s Manual.




